

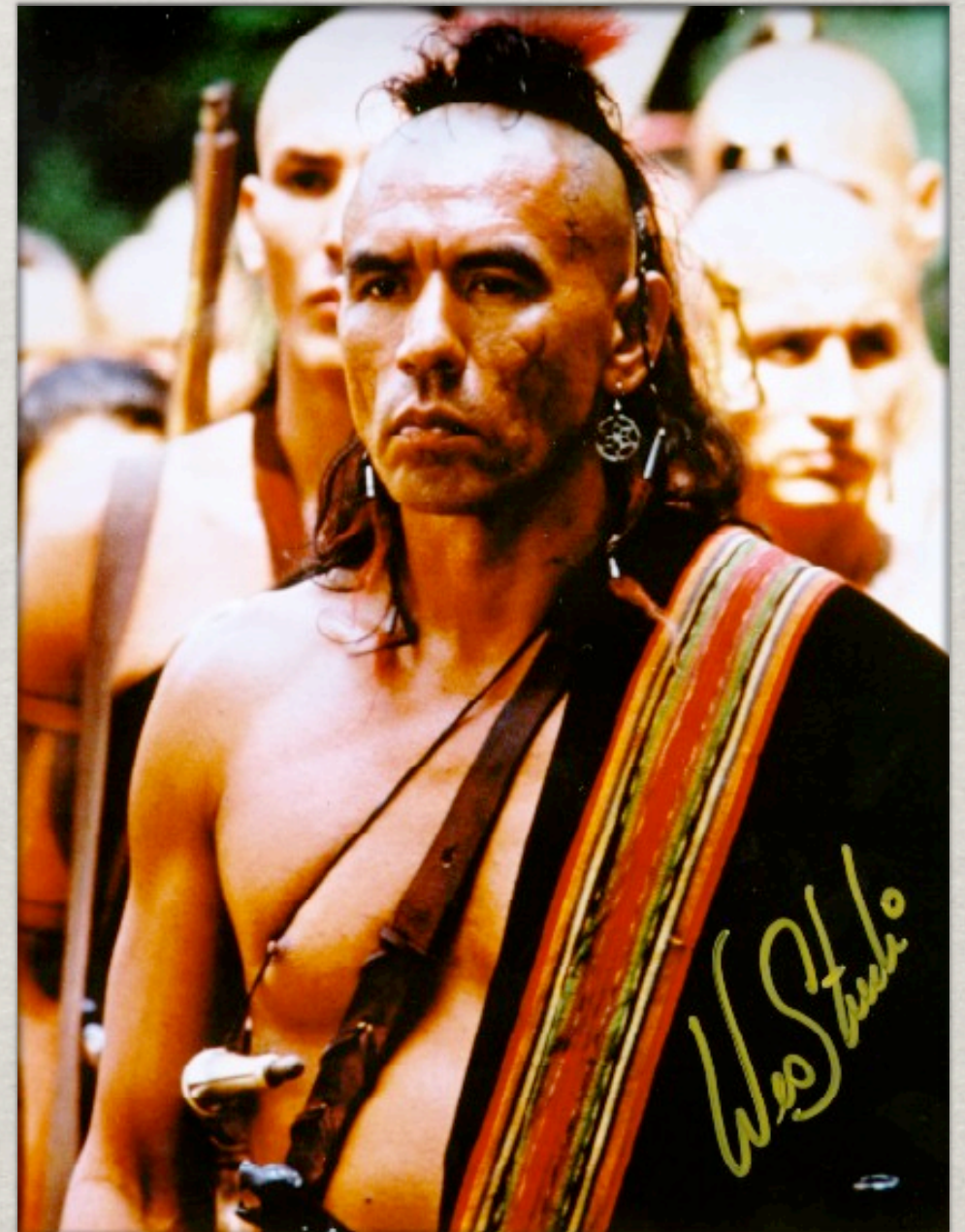
INDIAN RESISTANCE

- ✻ Refuse to assimilate.
- ✻ Refuse to sell tribal land.
- ✻ Refuse to move off the land.
- ✻ Defend tribal sovereignty before the U.S. Supreme Court
- ✻ Unify tribes & organize armed resistance.



REFUSE TO ASSIMILATE

- ✻ Resist conversion to Christianity & keep Native spiritual traditions
- ✻ Use tribal language & refuse to use English
- ✻ Observe tribal customs, celebration ceremonies, family & gender roles



REFUSE TO SELL LAND

- ✻ Organize tribes as a united front to refuse to sell land to whites or U.S. government
- ✻ Send tribal members to be educated at white universities to learn to navigate the U.S. legal system in order to resist illegal violations of treaties



REFUSE TO MOVE TO RESERVATIONS

- ✿ Stay on tribal land & attack whites as they move in illegally
- ✿ Organize warriors to attack & destroy white farms, roads & railroad tracks built in tribal land illegally
- ✿ Unite with other tribes to fight the United States military's forced removal of tribes
- ✿ Organize tribe to flee for Canada (or mountain regions)
